Key highlights in 2023

- growing network of partnerships with countries of origin and transit
- enhanced operational presence in the WBs
- concrete operational results along key migratory routes to the EU
- closer relations with Southern Neighbourhood countries
- returns supported by Frontex ↑ 60%
- fundamental rights - promoted across all activities in the external dimension



Dialogue and structured cooperation frameworks

- Pre-accession partners
- Africa and the Middle East
- Silk Routes countries and Central Asia
- Trans-Atlantic cooperation and other partners
- Latin America



Pre-accession countries

- utmost priority in the external dimension
- MoU fundamental rights - Albania; Moldova
- negotiations with all Western Balkans partners and Moldova to renew WA
- biennial exchange between Frontex MB and EU pre-accession partners hosting joint operations, including for the 1st time Ukraine, Moldova, Georgia



Cooperation with the Western Balkans countries

- New EUR 7 million technical assistance intervention in the Western Balkans
- Launch of JO North Macedonia in 2023

2023: Joint response at the borders

- Fully-fledged Joint Operations under EU Status Agreements

- Albania
- Montenegro
- Moldova
- Serbia
- North Macedonia



2023: JO Coordination Points

- JO without executive powers by deploying Standing Corps officers as EU experts
- 3 JO Coordination Points implemented in 2023:
 - JO Coordination Points Air, Land and Sea 2023, hosted by Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Georgia, Moldova , Montenegro and North Macedonia
 - JO Coordination Points Serbia 2023, hosted at air and land BCPs
 - JO Coordination Points Kosovo* 2023, hosted at air and land BCPs
- EMPACT - 6 JADs

Africa and the Middle East; Silk Routes countries



- along Central and Western Mediterranean Routes:
 - closer relations:
Morocco, Lebanon, Jordan
 - reopened dialogue:
Egypt, Tunisia
- in the Silk Routes region strengthening ties: Pakistan

Pre-return assistance

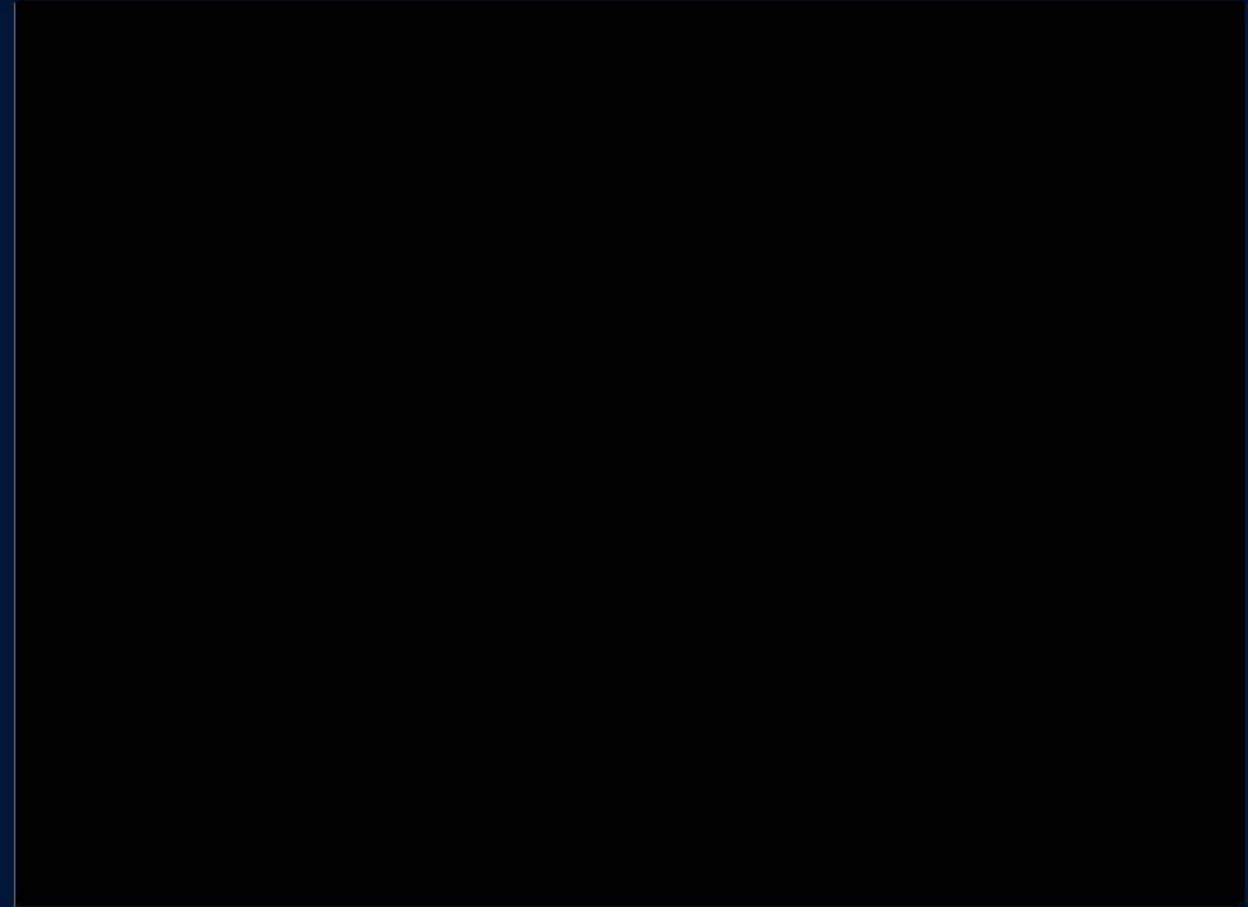
- Enhanced the operational and technical cooperation with countries of return:
 - supporting deployment of EURLOs.
 - supporting the organisation of identification missions.
 - deployment of SC with Return Specialist profile.
 - use of the Readmission Case Management Systems (RCMS).
 - technical assistance activities.

Returns - EURLOs

Coordinated deployment of 9 EURLOs covering 13 TCs:

→ EURLOs support MS & Frontex in enhancing cooperation on return-related activities:

- pre-return
- return operations & voluntary returns
- post-arrival & reintegration.



Return operations

- Frontex technical and operational support to MS for return of 39231 individuals to 112 TCs of destination.

Return Operations & Voluntary Returns by Air in 2023

- 54% voluntary-based returns.
- 71% on scheduled flights.

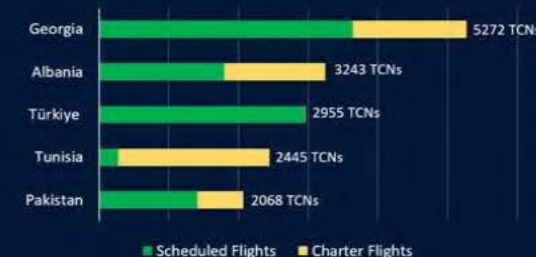

Post-return and reintegration

- Active support to reintegration assistance in 35 TCs in partnership with non-profit reintegration partners through the EU Reintegration Programme.
- No direct involvement of the TCs authorities in reintegration cooperation.
- 3 proposed Technical Assistance Projects for TCs on Return, Readmission and Reintegration (TAP4RRR) - development of well-coordinated referral and reintegration mechanisms & strengthening reintegration counselling capacities.
